

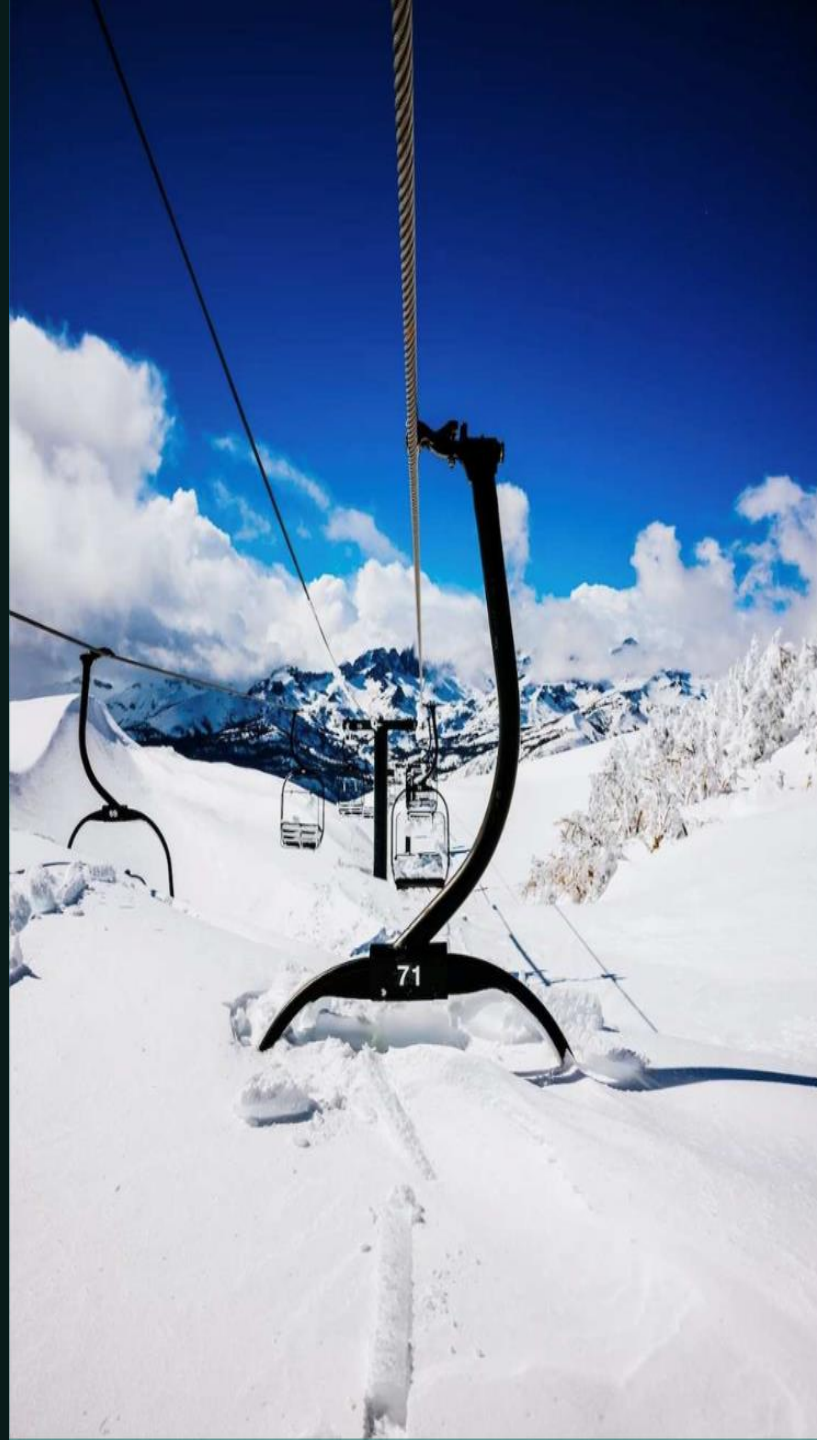

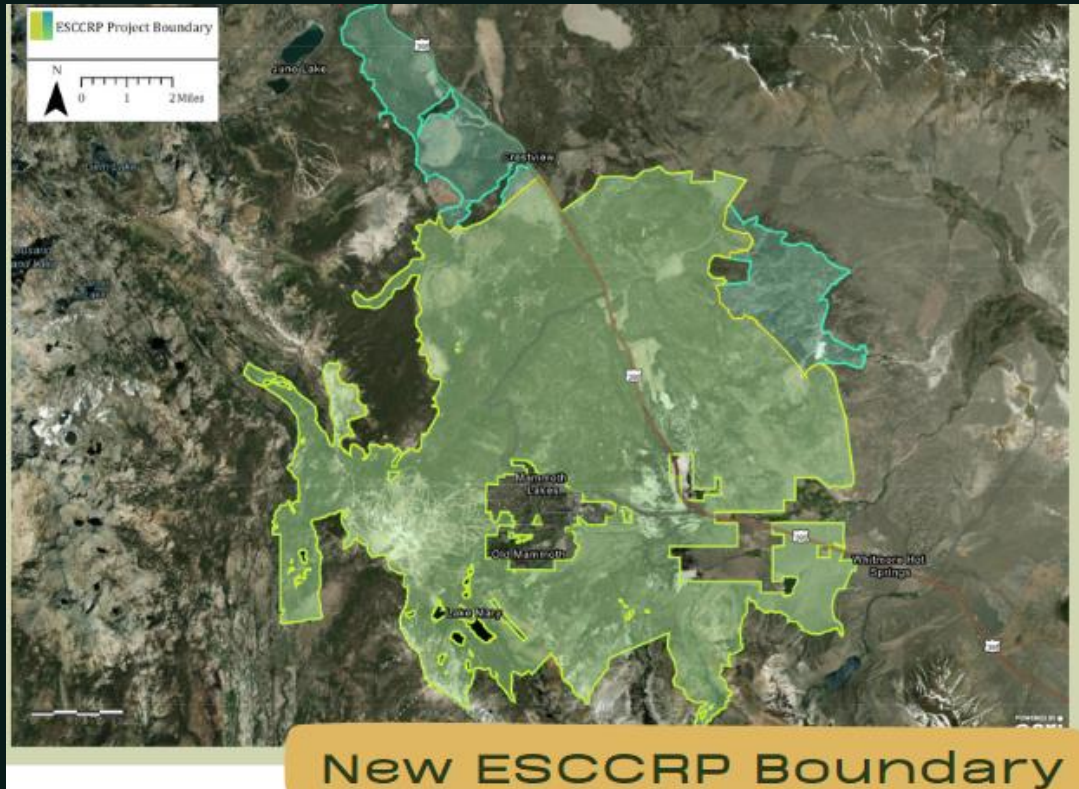

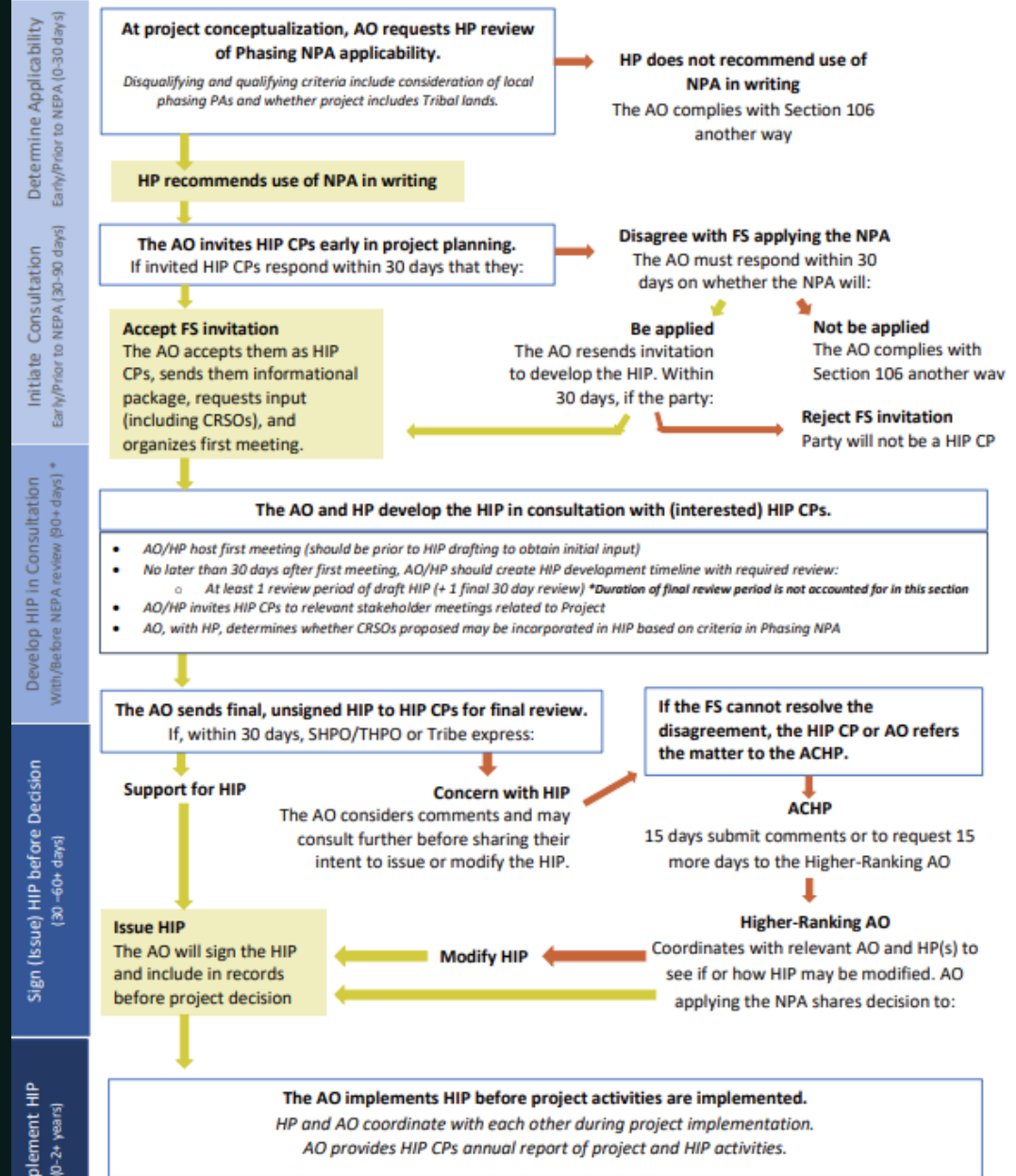

PA = Programmatic Agreement

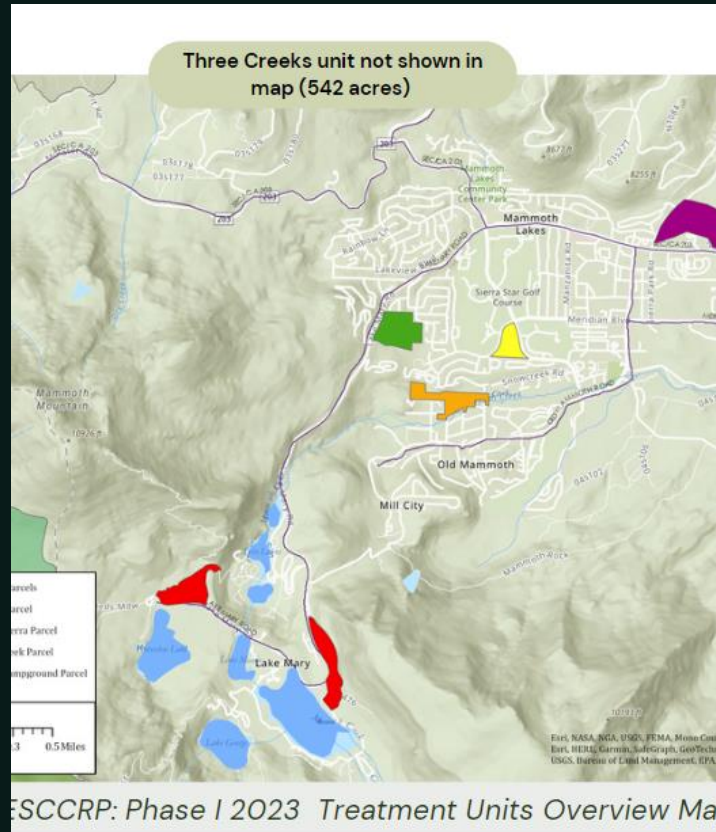

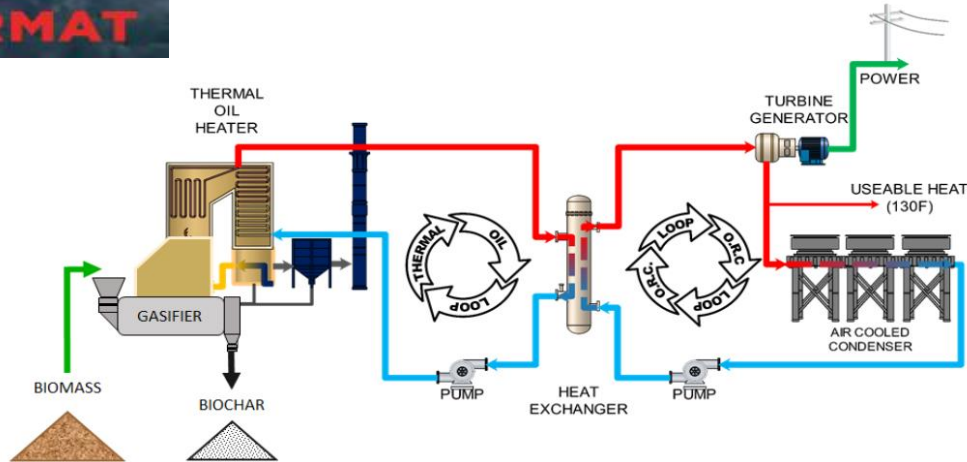
